Some of the information in this booklet is subject to change as planning continues. Final details will be confirmed late 2016. No major changes to the program will be made.



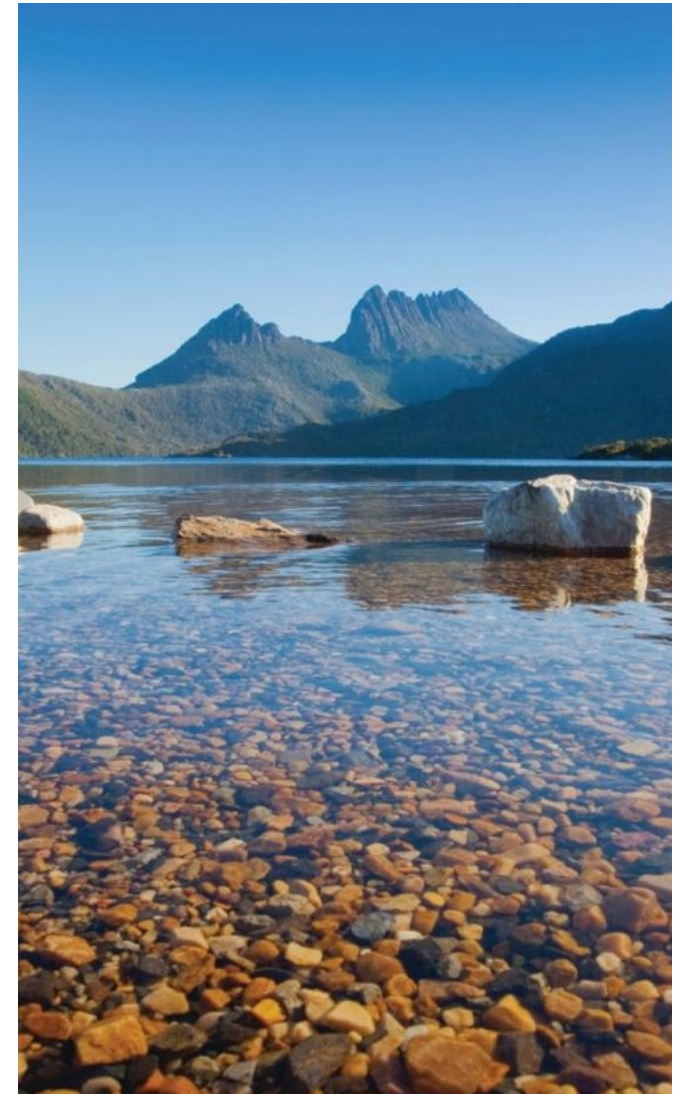
